

BEML COMMITS TO CONSTRUCT 500 HOUSES AT FLOOD HIT AREAS OF NORTHERN KARNATAKA

BEML LIMITED, the Public Sector Company under the Ministry of Defence, headquartered at Bangalore is having its production units at Bangalore, Kolar Gold Fields and Mysore, all located in Karnataka.

In response to the call of the Govt. of Karnataka, BEML has immediately contributed Rs. Two Crores to Chief Minister's Relief Fund being its mite comprising to a day's wages of employees and executives of the company's contribution towards rehabilitation of the victims affected by the recent floods in the northern part of the State.

Further, in response to the call of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka, BEML has also committed to construct around 500 dwelling units to rehabilitate the flood affected poor people who lost their properties. These houses would be constructed at Raichur District as allotted by the Govt., at a total cost of Rs.5 Crores and would be named as "BEML BLOCK." After construction, these dwelling units would be maintained by BEML for a period of 5 years through a Service Provider as a part of its Corporate Social Responsibility.
